### To ensure that the game is played safely, golfers must observe the following rules:

- Wash your hands and your golf equipment before you leave home.
- Aim to arrive no more than 15 minutes prior to play.
- Park your car in such a way as to facilitate physical distancing.
- Observe physical distancing rules at all times following your arrival at the club and on the course.
- The changing rooms will be open but we recommend you change your shoes in the car park.
- By law, face coverings must be worn in all shops, including retail shops in golf clubs.
- Do not arrive at the first tee more than 5 minutes before your allotted tee time.
- Following play of a hole, do not enter the next box until all members of the group in front have played their tee-shots and exited the tee box.
- If you use a golf buggy, it must only be used by you and cannot be shared.
- Do not exchange or share equipment, food or drink with other players during your round.
- Do not use on-course water fountains, ball cleaners etc.
- Do not use rakes in bunkers.
- Do not touch the flagstick. Putt with the flagstick in, remove your own ball from the hole.
- Bring your own hand sanitiser to the course & use regularly during the round.
